FAQs

What class should my child be in?

Classes are divided by **grade completed as of June 2020.** Please refer to the attached registration form, find your child's grade and make your selection. Contact the NSO for assistance.

Does my child need an instrument? Instruments are provided for all Early Years programmes, as well as Piano, Recorder, Handbells, Harp and Percussion. For all other classes, students must bring or rent an instrument. Please see "Instrument Rental" on the payment section on side 2 of the registration form.

How long is camp? Full-day classes run 9:00 AM – 3:30 PM; half-day classes dismiss at noon or begin at 1:00 PM; Sessions 1 and 2 run two weeks each. Late pickup fees apply (\$1 per minute after 10 minutes late)

Is there before and after care? Extended care is available from 8:30 – 9:00 AM and 3:30 – 5:30 PM for a flat fee of \$80.

What about lunch? An optional lunch service is available through The Lunch Lady, delivering lunches directly to camp. Details and order forms available upon registration. Free Pizza Day on the first Friday of each session.

ORCHESTRAL & COMBINATION PROGRAMMES:

Orchestral programmes offer technique and repertoire classes on one instrument; includes participation in ensemble, orchestra and concert band. Combination programmes allow campers to select 1 or 2 half-day classes. 30-minute Harp option for grades 4 & up, both sessions.
